#### The third season of Miata Trophy is about to begin!

On Saturday 15 March the single-make championship returns, with two generations of Mazda MX-5 competitors itching to kickstart their season in the best fashion possible.

Continuing in the championships trend of starting each season at a different venue, the technical Snetterton 300 circuit will play host to the opening two rounds of the season. Both races taking place on a single day will provide plenty of entertainment for both driver and spectator in Norfolk, with expectations high for an enthralling day of action.

Miata Trophy's two previous overall Champions, Declan Lee and John Langridge, are set to be on the grid, alongside a blend of both championship regulars and debutants.

Will Morris recorded an impressive double victory at Snetterton last year and is also amongst those returning to the grid for the 2025 season opener. The Hills Motorsport driver will be looking to take to the podium once more, but it will surely be no easy feat. Every competitor will be looking to maximise their points haul and create a solid platform to launch their seasons aspirations.

The Snetterton 300 circuit held its first race back in 2011 following an extensive redevelopment, including the

addition of the new infield section of track, moving it away from the older configuration now most closely resembled by the 200 circuit.

This redevelopment makes Snetterton arguably one of the best tracks for racing in the country, with its combination of fast and technical corners and the longest straights in Norfolk, to challenge even the most decorated of competitor.

New-for-2025 in Miata Trophy is a shake-up the championship's qualifying format. A 15-minute qualifying session will first set the grid for race one. Race two will take the same initial positions, but with the top ten reversed!

A fourteen-round calendar is in place for the 2025 Miata Trophy season, including race meetings at all three of Great Britain's active Grand Prix circuits! Three classes make up the grid, with Class NC and Class ND welcoming Mk3 and Mk4 Mazda-MX-5 respectively, and Class ND Maxi providing a platform for Mk4 models with non-compliant suspension, gearbox or camshaft.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Miata Trophy is a one make Championship for the Mk3 and Mk4 Mazda MX-5. Racing together yet scoring points separately, allows cars from either class to take the overall championship title.

#### RACES

Two 20 minute sprint races follow a 15 minute qualifying, and the SuperPole session, a one lap dash to determine the top five grid positions in each class!

#### **POINTS AND REWARDS**

Points will be awarded to competitors listed as classified finishers within their class as follows: 50, 47, 44, 42, 40, 38, 36, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24 then decreasing by 2 points down the results until 24th in class where by all remaining classified finishers in class will receive 2 points. Points will be allocated for the fastest lap in each race and to each driver who crosses the control line in the overall lead during the race.

Control parts include, control tyre Toyo Proxes R888R tyre and control GAZ Gold coilovers suspension, amongst other items. Further details can be found on the Miata Trophy website.

Welcome to the first round of the 2025 MSVR All-Comers Racing Series at the iconic Snetterton 300 circuit! This year promises to deliver an electrifying season with diverse grids and thrilling action at some of the finest circuits in the UK. Opening on Saturday with two 20-minute races around a track which offers both threats and thrills in equal measure is an exciting opportunity.

The Snetterton 300 Circuit poses a unique challenge with its diverse mix of corner types, including the long Senna and Bentley Straights and a complex second sector comprising five corners. This layout tested the skill and adaptability of drivers, adding an extra layer of excitement to the races.

The racing is split into two classes with factory-built racing and open cockpit cars filling Class 1, and Class 2 made up by race-prepared production-based cars. These allow for fierce competition throughout the grid and makes for wellearned trophies come the chequered flag.

We have a wide range of vehicles this weekend, ranging from Kevin Borland's Chevrolet Monte Carlo, to Dave Karaskas' Harrier LR4 Group C car. Amidst this remarkable content, I must thank each and every one of our drivers for supporting the MSVR All-Comers series and a special mention to those lining up on more than one grid over the weekend!



#### It's almost time for the first round of Trackday Championship's 2025 season!

On Saturday 15 March, Snetterton's 300 circuit will host the championship's opening race for the first time since TDC's debut in 2016.

Three classes of production saloon, hatchback, and sports car racers will all be keen to mark the occasion in memorable fashion, by securing a podium finish. Finishing in the top three of each class will not only be rewarded with a trophy, but also a strong helping of championship points to kickstart the competitors campaign.

2024 overall TDC Champion Nicole Drought (Motion Motorsport) will be aiming to begin her title defence in strong fashion, with a fresh look to her Honda Civic challenger. The 2024 Class C and Class D Champions, Wayne Cockerill (Aindale Racing) and Wright/Glover (Clubracer) are also set to return to the grid at Snetterton, albeit with the latter duo now taking on Class B in a Volkswagen Golf.

Expect the action to be competitive throughout each class! Snetterton should provide a fantastic platform for an entertaining season opener. The circuit's long straights will allow for competitors to put their engines through its paces, while challenging corners such as Coram and Murrays will test a driver's handling.

While difficult to master, the Norfolk circuit remains a favourite amongst track day drivers and racers alike for its ability to reward and frustrate in equal measure. Anticipation for an epic season opener is high!

Trackday Championship's established weekend format will remain in place for the upcoming season, with a 25-minute qualifying session proceeding a 45-minute race. The race itself will include a mandatory two-minute pit stop for all teams.

The championship's website (www.trackdaychampionship. com) will continue to be a go-to hub for everything this season – whether it be: live timings, race results, event galleries or more. Race reports posted after the event will give everyone the chance to relive the action, while the Championship Standings will keep you regularly updated with who is vying for the top spot.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The Trackday Championship is the graduate championship for Trackday Trophy drivers and other more experienced competitors in production and production-based sports and saloon cars. Further details can be found on the Trackday Championship website.

#### RACES

Races are designed for teams of two drivers so that the costs of running the car can be shared, together with the excitement! Classes are determined on a power-to-weight ratio and each race will be 45-minutes in length and preceded by a 25-minute qualifying session. These races will include a pit stop and allow for driver changes.

#### **POINTS AND REWARDS**

Points will be awarded to competitors listed as classified finishers in the final results as follows: 30, 27, 24, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 3, 2, 1, plus 1 for single fastest lap in qualifying or race. A maximum of 5 points will be added for cars beaten in class.

#### **TEAMS**

Teams can be made up of two drivers or solo entries. All teams must complete a pit-stop during the pit-stop window of between 15 minutes and 30 minutes into the race. All teams must complete two minute pit stop.

#### **SPECIFICATION**

Regulations for the series are reasonably relaxed to accommodate a wide range of vehicles.

All eyes are firmly fixed on Snetterton ahead of the season opener, where competitors will all be hoping to start their year with the best result possible.

Three classes of production and production-based saloon, hatchback and sports cars will combine on a single grid, with classes defined on a power-to-weight basis. Both new and returning faces will comprise the grid in Norfolk, with Trackday Trophy set to continue its rich vein of introducing novice drivers to the world of competitive motorsport in 2025.

Expect plenty of close battling throughout the entire field, for the duration of the 45-minute pit-stop race. Amongst those who will be hoping to be in the running for a class podium is Hills Motorsport's brother pairing of Roan and Ethan Lundy – who secured the win in Class D at Snetterton last year.

After claiming overall victory in Trackday Trophy's inaugural European round at Circuito de Navarra last year, Paddock Performance Racing's Michael Rawlings is another who will be looking for a strong season opener - in his freshly-liveried BMW E36. Team Wheelcare's Trevor Hurrell will be a driver to

keep an eye on in Class C, having topped the class at the first round of last year.

Whether you're an experienced racer or complete newcomer, Snetterton's 300 circuit will offer plenty. A technical infield section, containing the likes of Agostini and Oggies, will test competitors before the long Bentley Straight will give opportunity to open up their engines and blow away any winter break dust!

2025 mark an impressive milestone for Trackday Trophy, as it's the series' fifteenth year.

Races are designed with a mandatory pit-stop to give opportunity for two-driver teams to share the cost and excitement, with each race meeting containing both a 25-minute qualifying session and 45-minute race on the same day to help reduce overnight costs.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

MSVT Trackday Trophy is a series designed for production and production based Saloon, Hatchback and Sports cars. Aimed at trackday drivers, TDT is designed to help introduce newcomers to the world of motorsport.

#### RACES

Races are designed for teams of two drivers so that the costs of running the car can be shared, together with the excitement! Classes are determined on a power-to-weight ratio and each event consists of 25 minutes practice/qualifying, followed by a 45 minute race, both of which will take place on one day to reduce overnight costs.

The MSVT Trackday Trophy is run as a series, so there are no championship points.

#### **SPECIFICATION**

Cars must be fully compliant with Motorsport UK regulations (roll cage, fire extinguisher and cut-off switches) but the regulations for the series are reasonably relaxed, so that drivers who have already developed cars for trackdays without having to follow a set of regulations will still be eliqible.

attendance. The off-season will have provided opportunity
for teams to have reimagined their cars and an array of
creatively-liveried KAs have already been spotted on track
days across the country in 2025, so expect the battle for the
Dagenham Dustbin to be fierce!

EnduroKA remains a fantastic platform for novice drivers to experience first-hand the thrills of racing for the first time and the series is delighted to welcome a number of new faces to the paddock at Snetterton.

Made possible due to the sustained popularity of the series since its launch, EnduroKA is back for a seventh consecutive season in 2025 and we can't wait to get things started this weekend!



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#### **LIGHTS AND FLAGS**

#### **BLUE (STEADY)**

Another competitor is close.

#### BLUE (WAVED)

Another competitor is trying to pass.

#### WHITI

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

#### YELLOW (WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

#### YELLOW (DOUBLE WAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking. (This signal may be supplemented or replaced by flashing yellow light(s), as an added warning).

#### YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

#### **GREEN (WAVED)**

All dear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and shown at all posts during first lap of each practice session and during the formation lap.

#### RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals (at startline & individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.

#### **BLACK/ORANGE DISK**

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

#### **BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL**

Warning to driver that his/her behaviour (e.g. corner cutting) is suspect and he/her may be black flagged.

#### BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.




